



## Installation Specification for InterfaceNZ Carpet Tile

Ensure that the Sub-Floor is clean, level, smooth and permanently dry and free from rising moisture as per AS/NZS 2455-2007. The substrate is to be seal with the use of an approved Primer.

Adhesive to be used shall be Inter-Tac as manufactured specifically for Interface carpet tile. Application of adhesive shall be by the 'Full Spread' method preferably using a roller or spray system.

All Interface carpet tiles are to be laid directly onto Inter-Tac releasable adhesive that has been allowed to tack off. Colour will change to a 'clear' texture [from green] and not transfer to the back of the tile.

Alternatively TacTiles may be used in place of Inter-Tac where it is expressly stated in the specification document.

Carpet tile shall be installed by qualified contractors in accordance with InterfaceFLOR's installation manual (2007 edition – available on [www.InterfaceNZ.com/documents&warranties](http://www.InterfaceNZ.com/documents&warranties)) and as directed by AS/NZS 2455.2 (Standard for installation practices of carpet tile) published by Standards N.Z.).

InterfaceNZ or an approved contractor is to be contacted for recycling of existing or uplifted PVC backed carpet tile.
