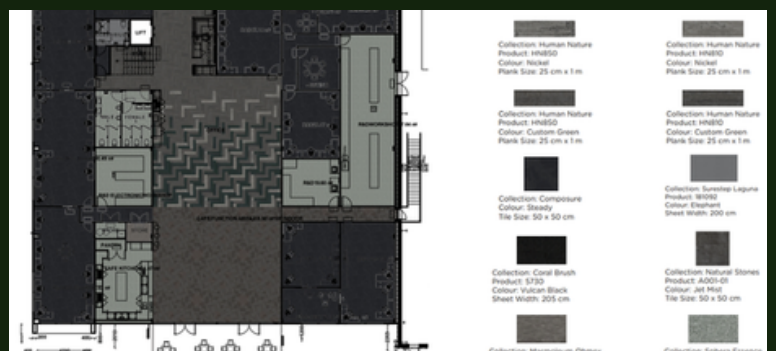

Colour in Education Spaces

There is perhaps no more important space to harness the power of good design than in that of education. When children have a positive experience of education at an early age, it inspires and stimulates them, and can ignite a passion for learning.

So, what colours can actually enhance creativity, focus and concentration? Of course cultural and social influences will affect this, but when looking for colours that have universal appeal those drawn from nature can tap into positive experiences shared by all, best explained through the Ecological Valence Theory.

Green is known to be the easiest colour for the retina to perceive and, as such, is the best for long-term concentration, while blue has been found to boost creativity and enhance participants' ability to think 'outside of the box'. It is thought that the association with water and the sky makes us open and calm enough to be explorative and creative. Blue has also been linked with improved productivity. Therefore, in a learning environment, it would be useful to use blue where difficult subjects are taught or students may ordinarily experience stress.

However, to avoid the colour scheme becoming too monochromatic, warmer shades such as yellows, oranges and reds can help to create a more lively and cheerful atmosphere. As with anything, use these bolder colours in moderation, particularly for younger students who are already prone to over stimulation.

Overall, colours can be a cost effective and impactful way to create the desired feeling of a space. Cooler colours are good for calm, focus and concentration, whereas warmer colours help students to stay happy, alert and attentive, and add a youthful touch.

BACKING OPTIONS

Acoustic performance is essential when creating environments conducive to learning, that is why the options in this swatch surpass the NZBC impact insulation requirements.

Tested on a standard 100mm concrete slab, Glasbac Acoustic Vinyl Backing has a FIIC rating of 61 and CushionBacRe achieves a FIIC of 66. A pass is IIC55.

GlasBac backing is a high performing backing which has been used in education environments in New Zealand for over 20 years. Cushion backing is a unique felt backing ideal for use in multi-story buildings and where improved underfoot comfort is important.



ENTRANCE MATTING

It is highly recommended that entrance matting is installed at every entry/exit point of a building for at least 1.8m, ideally 3m. This removes liquids, dirt and contaminants from wheels, shoes and feet, reducing slip risks and keeping your floor investment looking and performing better.
